### **Banks & Title maps of entire states**

#### Bank of America

1978 & 82 CA map (HMG) does not list locations on the map nor list offices or branches

#### Bank of Hawaii

10/81 HI map made by HMG. HMG code AN-81. **Used lowercase "hg" with shadows symbol.** 3 offices on Kauai, 26 on Oahu, one on Molokai, 7 on Maui, and 12 on the big island of Hawaii.

4/88 & 10/88 HI maps-now with 60 branches & ATMs.

#### Bank of Delaware

mid 70's Delaware road map, details unknown

#### Chemical Bank

~2012 Four Flags map (Benton Harbor to South Bend) has an ad with a simple MI map showing 142 locations with white dots. From Traverse City to the MI/IN border. Merger with TCF Bank in 2019.

TCF was merged into Huntington Bank in 2021.

#### Citizens Bank

2007 Mass Pike MA lists all MA branches of Citizens Bank-none shown on any maps.

#### First Interstate Bank

1980 Tucson Street atlas (Phoenix Mapping) shows all AZ locations on a map using their orange "I" logo.

1982 Reno map (Compass Maps) uses an orange number inside an orange circle for 18 Reno/Sparks

area offices. On an inside panel is a map with **small black dots** showing 900 offices and ATMs. They cover CA, OR, WA, ID, nw-MT, Casper & Laramie-WY, UT, nc-CO, NV, AZ, nw, nc, & se-NM.

1983 Las Vegas map (Compass Maps) uses an **italic capital "I" outlined in orange symbols** to show offices and ATMs. **It has the same 11 state map with small black dots for locations.**

These two maps are listed because they show locations in 11 states and not just for one city.

First National Bank of Hawaii (62, 64)/First Hawaiian Bank (69, 72 & 92)

1962 & 64 HI maps (RMcN) has **solid blue stars showing locations of branches** and back covers that says that their 14-story office bldg. in the tallest in downtown Honolulu.

1969 HI map (RMcN) has **solid red stars showing branch locations.**

1972 HI First Hawaiian Bank map (RMcN) has **solid red stars** on Honolulu & Hilo maps

Front cover has a beautiful color photo of 20 surfers in Surfers Cove.

1992 HI map made by HMG. Then branded First Hawaiian Bank. Hmg code 92-UH. Uses **solid gold dot** symbol. Has 5 offices on Kauai, 40 on Oahu, one on L'anai, 7 on Maui, and 7 on the big island of Hawaii.

Gibraltar Savings

1980 TX map made by HMG-HMG code AC. **Uses solid red dots symbols** and shows 6 Amarillo, 1-Lubbock, 3-Midland, 18 Dallas/Ft Worth, 2-Austin/SanAntonio, 17 Houston, & 10 Corpus Christi offices.

Hellman Bank

1924 CA map shows 30 branch addresses on the back cover with inset maps of LA & SF.

Home Federal Savings of San Diego

1980 & ~1981 CA (RMcN) maps-unsure if locations are listed

Home Savings and Loan

1968 (LA Freeway map) by Western Map Co showed with **gold shield symbols** showing locations

After this they switched to the state map listed below

7/76, 9/78, 11/79, & 1/81 CA maps (HMG) **white number in red dots** on city insets of SF/Santa Cruz, Sacramento, LA, and San Diego. All dates are from the back bottom corner.

Home Savings of America All Home Savings maps use **white number in a black dot symbol**

1982 (9/82) FL map (HMG)--towns and addresses on the back-most along

Atlantic coast from Vero Beach to north of Miami. Expanding along Gulf coast Tampa to Ft.

Myers. Back cover dated 9/82. Now using the trade name Home Savings of America.

1983 (4/83) TX

1983 (9/82) CA & 1983 MO (4/83) maps-(HMG)-CA branches in Sacramento, SF Bay area, greater LA, & San Diego. MO branches near St Louis & Poplar Bluff.

Savings of America (on the front cover) back covers a division of Home Savings of America.

An Ahmanson Company (on 1987 & 1988 maps)

1983 Savings of America FL & TX exist 10/83 code on both back covers. 37 TX offices in the Dallas, San Antonio, Houston/Beaumont areas and coming soon to Austin & Ft Worth. **White numbers in a black solid dot** show the location on city inset maps 6 near Houston & Port Arthur.

10/83 & 12/87 IL maps (HMG) dates from back covers. **10/83 Savings branches-white numbers in black dots, 12/87 also has Savings & Loan offices-number in a black dot outlined in black, Loan office black numbers in a white dot outlined in black.** All branches in nearby suburbs of Chicago..

1985 (10/84) NY state map (HMG)--towns and addresses on the back. 16 branches (one in Queens-rest on Long Island). Back cover date 10/84.

12/87 MO map (HMG) shows expansion to Kansas City and Springfield. Both maps HMG code WJ-88.

1988 OH map uses **Full service offices-white numbers in a black dot, Loan office black numbers in a white dot outlined in black.** HMG map code AN-88. All branches near Cincinnati, Columbus, Zanesville, Fremont, Findlay, Marion, & Mansfield. None in Toledo, Cleveland, Akron, Dayton, or se-Ohio.  
1993 IL (HMG) map shows 10 offices in greater Chicago with **white numbers in a solid black dot.**

#### Howard Bank

1976 Heritage Bicentennial VT map. **White H inside red dot shows locations near Rutland.** All the branches listed on the back cover.

#### International Savings

1985 HI map (HMG) uses a **blue IS symbol with I dotted by a blue globe with a blue arrow pointing to a blue dot.** The back cover lists 14 offices (11-Oahu, 1-Hilo, 2 on Maui) The offices are shown on the city inserts only and the Maui branches are not shown on the map.

#### Marine Midland Bank

1975 NY state map (GDC) has **green numbers in green circles for branches and "mm" for ATMs.**  
1978 NY state map (GDC) has **a white sailing ship inside a blue rectangle for offices and "mm" inside a blue circle for MoneyMatic ATMs.** There is a list of ATMs on the back of the map. All branches are between Buffalo and Syracuse.

#### Norwest Bank

1993 WI map (RMcN) exists-uncertain if locations listed or shown  
1995 MN map lists 44 Twin City offices and 33 outstate branches on the back cover. On the back cover is a simple MN map with small dots showing the locations. In 1998 Norwest was bought by Wells Fargo and rebranded.

#### San Diego Federal

1974, 77, & 79 CA maps (HMG) "California Adventure" map back cover lists 30 branches (1974), 45 branches (1977), 58 (1979) in and near Sacramento, Monterey, Fresno, Hollywood, & Palm Springs. Most branches were located in San Diego County. Branches were listed using **red and blue squares with rounded corners with three white sea gulls in the middle.**

#### Security-First National Bank of Los Angeles

1929 CA (copyright by Security-1st Natl) shows towns and LA Suburbs printed in red where branches are located. One side of the map is CA and the other is LA/Redlands. Branches are as far north as Fresno.  
~mid-1940's CA map shows branches on the LA map with black stars. Says it has branches from Fresno to Imperial Valley (branches not shown on the state map). Originally started by Hellman Bank.

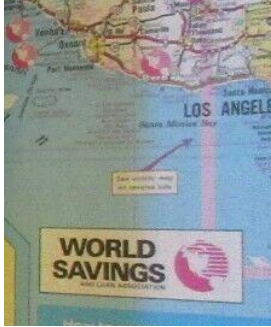
#### Title Guarantee-New York

1982 NY state map (GDC) showing 15 offices with the **4 blue bend lines making a cube symbol** on the map and city insets. The back cover date is 1/83.

#### World Savings and Loan Ass'n

~1979/80 CA map made by HMG-shows each branch with a **North America outline between a solid red Pacific Ocean and a red and white striped Atlantic inside a red globe symbol.** On the back all 97 branches are listed from Chico to San Diego.

1980 CO map made by HMG-Mapde code AN. **Uses the same red and white round symbol** listed above.30 branches from Ft Collins to Colorado Springs with one outlier in Buena Vista in central CO.



### Yankee 24 (ATM)

4/90 & 9/90 New England road maps (General Drafting) exist. The index shows all towns with their ATM machines printed in blue. The cover says 3700 ATMs in 675 New England towns.  
~1991 New England map (GDC) now has 3800 ATMs in 700 towns

## Nacar, NFL, Railroad Atlases & other unusual location maps

### Air Force Reserve

~1974 Pocket Road atlas (Diversified Map) has double page showing all airports and Air Force Bases that have Reserve units. 5 in CA, 3-TX, none in ID, MT, ND, SD, WY, NE, IA, NV, CO, NM, AR, KY, TN, WV, ME, VT, CT, RI, VA, & NC.

### American Express

1970 CA (HMG) American Express Space Bank map (co-sponsored by Avis). Space Bank locations shown with **SB on 2 sides of a blue cube symbol**. Most along coastal California in Eureka and from San Francisco to San Diego. A few inland in Reno, Sacramento, and Fresno. Avis locations shown with white numbers inside a solid red dot. Space Bank was a travel service making travel reservations for American Express customers and not a consumer bank.

1982 USA (HMG) USA map shows American Express Travel offices on the back of the map.

### American Legion

1987 US map (Gen'l Drafting) shows Veterans Admin. regional office & medical clinics with **blue dots & solid orange squares** with 2-letter state codes & numbers, w/ addresses on the back.

1995 US map that shows VA offices and clinics also exists.

### Ask Mr. Foster Travel Service

~1934 (Western States & Canada) WA/OR/ID/MT/WY/CO/CA/NV/UT/AZ/NM/Western Canada map  
Undated Grayson's map dated by road construction and US hwy numbers. Side panel lists all 69 travel offices in the US and Canada. Many were located inside major hotels and dept. stores. The Minneapolis office was inside the L S Donaldson Co. dtwn. dept. store. On the back of the map are reliable hotels and resorts recommended by Ask Mr. Foster. These hotels are located in the 10 states and western Canada mentioned on the map cover. No hotels or travel offices are shown on the map.

1939 Western States & Canada also exists.

### Bekins Van Lines

Bekins' service area was from the West Coast to Sioux City, Iowa. An early 1905 is known from Los



Angeles, and a 1915 California state map (co-sponsored by TransContinental Freight)  
Since they were a moving & storage company all the rest of their maps were city or county maps.

Pasadena/Glendale (31, 32, 40, 50, 61), Redwood City/Palo Alto (56), Sacramento (51),  
San Bernardino/Riverside/Redlands-(**54**), San Diego (36, 41, 55, **58**),  
San Fernando Valley (50, 54), San Francisco (7/1908, 39, **46**, **48**, **53**, 56, 61, 63),  
San Gabriel Valley (60), San Jose/Santa Clara (57), Santa Ana (unknown),  
Santa Barbara (34, 39, **48**, 52, 55, 59, 63, 65, 67).  
WA-Kennewick/Pasco/Richland (50, 60), Seattle (1913, 53, 65), Spokane (62), Tacoma (62), &  
Yakima (47, 57, 59).  
OR-Portland (51, 57, 62) & Eugene (54).  
ID-Boise (53)  
AZ-Tucson (early 50s) also likely Phoenix  
CO-Denver (circa 1940s).  
IA-Sioux City (1940s c1950, 1961).  
Nebraska-Omaha-(**50**, **4/57**, 63)  
Canada-Vancouver/Buraby/New Westminster-c1950, Winnipeg (undated)  
Most of the city maps showed their warehouse(s).

**1941 San Diego map shows the major city warehouse with a large black Bekins logo and a black arrow.** Also lists a new branch office on map. Both addresses are listed as well as all towns with Bekins agents in WA, OR, CA, and Phoenix.

#### Boy Scouts

1964 Campways/BSA Road Atlas-list of overnight group sites and high-adventure areas.

#### Casino map of Eastern Oklahoma

**2014 map-85 casinos on map using numbers inside black dots and poker chips**

Addresses on back with name of Indian tribe that owns each

#### Caterpillar Parts & Service

**1980 US/Canada (RMcN) map uses small red dots to show locations. All dealer names & towns listed on the back.**

Continental Trailways Bus 1960 Road Atlas lists towns of addresses of each bus depot.

#### DOX/Dixie Ohio Express

1964 Large RMcN Road Atlas (US-Canada-Mexico). Inside front cover map of Terminals from Buffalo-Ny to Birmingham-Al. Terminals are listed in 3-AL, 3-GA, 2-KY, 1-Buffalo, 1-Erie-Pa, 9-OH, and 3-TN..

#### Fruehauf (Truck) Trailers

1960 (medium) Road Atlas (RMcN) lists 67 Fruehauf locations and 10 distributors addresses on the back cover. No locations in AK, HI, ID, WY, NM, SC, VT, NH, & ME.

Garrett Freightlines **1962 US map (HMG) Terminal cities printed in red and operating routes overprinted in red.** Based in Idaho, many routes in Washington, Idaho, and Utah, with routes to

San Francisco, Los Angeles, Albuquerque, Denver, and St Paul.

#### Greyhound Bus Lines

1946 US map shows routes with **solid black lines**.

June-1946 US map shows routes with **red lines layered over a hwy map**.

1981 Greyhound Picture Window US map (GDC) shows routes with a **blue overlay over highways**

1988 Greyhound US route map exists

1997 US Route map uses **gray highways** for their routes and **green dashes** for connecting routes.

#### HIP Rutgers

1989 NY/NJ/FL map (General Drafting) The map actually covers NJ, greater NYC, Long Island, and coastal southeast Florida. Health Insurance Plan had clinics in metropolitan NYC, the state of NJ, and southeast coastal Florida. The NJ offices are called HIP-Rutgers Health Plan and marked on the map with **HIP-Rutgers in a solid red rectangle**.

ICX 1971 & 73 US map (HMG) Operating **routes overprinted in red**. Based in Denver. Main routes Chicago to San Francisco, Chicago to Amarillo, TX, and LA to Dallas. Terminals listed in upper right corner of the US map. Aka Illinois California Express. Bankrupt and closed in 1984.

#### Knott's Berry Farm

Early 60's until mid-70's undated brochures (dated by road construction) were issued every year or two and all have with directions to the park shown with **two large arrows on the LA map showing the park**.

1977/78, 79, & 1980/81 CA (dated) maps show theme park location **with large blue arrow pointing to Knott's inside blue circle** on the LA inset.

1992 Buena Park (CA) map co-sponsored by Knotts Berry Farm has other ads for TraveLodge, Hampton, & Courtyard Hotels.

#### Lester's Farm Bldg Systems

1983-MN-(RMcN-map) shows mfg plant Lester Prairie (MN) with a **green "L" Lester logo**.

1983-IA, SD, & WI maps are all by Rand McNally.

#### Lyons Fire Proof Storage

1923 Los Angeles shows 2 warehouses with **2 large orange arrows pointing to two orange lions with a Lyons sign on his back**.

1967 Santa Barbara map shows a warehouse with **a large blue wedge**.

#### Mayflower (Worldwide Movers)

1955 RMcN Special Road Atlas has the names and towns of each agent inside the front and back cover.

1958 RMCN Special Road Atlas has all agent names & towns in the US, 58 in Canada, & 67 in countries around the world.

#### Merchants Motor Freight

1949 (RMcN) road atlas, inside front cover shows service area-Denver-Iowa-Mpls-St Paul-Chicago-KC.

#### Military Road Atlas

2005 Military Living Road Atlas shows all Military bases on the map with color symbols.



Marine Corp symbols is Eagle/globe/anchor; Coast Guard-Life Preserver

#### Morgan Drive Away

1966 large RMCN US road atlas has a US map on front inside cover with HQ in Indiana and 16 district offices from Ca to Ny to Fl.

#### Navajo Freight Lines

1971 US maps shows all Terminals and routes-CA AZ-CO-IL-MI-NY-MA-MD-with **heavy black lines and dots**

#### Nascar

1990 Pocket Road atlas by Alka-Seltzer has the regional race schedule for NASCAR regional tracks. 2001, 02, 03, 04, 05, 06, 07, & 08 Road Atlases (SportsMap-the Lawrence Group).

Inset maps show diagrams of racetracks, and stands for each major track. 2001, 02, 03, & 04- Winston Cup series, 2005-Nextel Cup series, 2008-Sprint Cup series. 2004 & 08 show NASCAR sanctioned tracks.

Nascar 2006 Fedex Racing (Nextel) Road Atlas (SportsMap). Same as 2005 except the covers.

Nascar 2007 & 08 Ultimate Road Trip Guide (Rand McNally) A Road Atlas with all 31 sanctioned tracks. Two versions of the 2008 atlas, one with Shell car on cover and Shell ad on the back cover.

#### National Guard

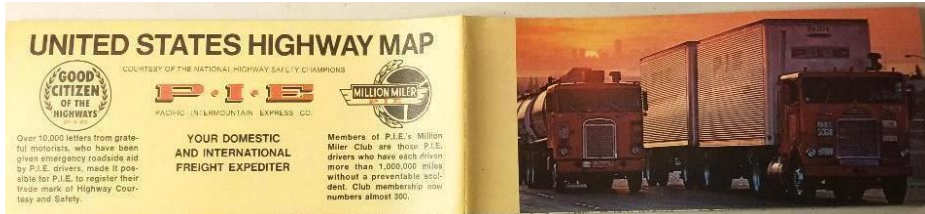
2006 US (RMcN medium) Road Atlas-shows all towns with National Guard facilities with **red dots**.

NFL 2000 US Interstate Map "On the Road with the NFL" (SportsMaps) shows locations of each team on the US map and gives 2000 schedules and a diagram of each stadium.

#### Onan (RV Generators)

1989 US map (RMcN) Cummins Onan RV (GenSet) Generators has **solid red dots showing dealers** In the US and Canada

#### Pacific Intermountain Express



1970 & 71 Pacific Intermountain Express US map (HMG) shows all **domestic routes with red lines.**

The back lists 65 domestic truck terminals, air and ocean terminals and international cities served. They did not go to Phoenix or Tucson, any SE states, northern New England, no East Coast south of Washington DC. They did go to the panhandle of TX & between Windsor and Nigara Falls in Ontario. A Gousha archive map says a 2nd printing was done in 10/71—© in 1970. In 1959 I visited the Minneapolis terminal with my Cub Scout pack.

### Railroad Atlas



1978 & 1980 RR US Atlas shows routes of 40 major rail lines

### Roadway/Roadway Express

1977 & 79 Road Atlas (HMG) lists terminals inside the front cover. Inside back cover has a simple map showing towns of each terminal on the US map.

1987 Road Atlas has terminals inside back cover and a US map with terminals on the back cover

1994, 1997, 2000, 01 03, & 2005 Road Atlases list terminals on back cover on a US Map (inc Guam & Puerto Rico).. 1997-2003 are branded Roadway Express.

### Ruan Truck Rental

1994 US map shows red dots for all locations. Addresses listed on the back.

### Ski Areas (Maxwell House Coffee)

1982 Northeastern states (RMcN) shows ski areas from MN to ME with **blue skier silhouette** on the map. The back lists 71 ski resorts with services available at each. Color picture of a couple skiing On the front cover.

1983 Western States (RMcN) **Blue skier silhouette symbols** with a couple skiing on the front cover.

1983 Central & Western US & Eastern US maps (RMcN) co-sponsored by Connecticut Radio Network.

### CRN Ski areas

1984 Central & Western (RMcN) map co-sponsored by Campbell's Soup.

### U-Haul

1984 Large RMcN Road atlas-**orange dots** on US/Canada map, state, province, & city maps

show 1,100 (company-owned) locations in the US & Canada. (7,000+ total sites). In 1984 you could rent a trailer or truck for a move. You could also rent a RV (or get one fixed) or rent tools. Today they no longer rent RVs but still rent a lot of trailers and small trucks. When there business took off in the late 40s and 50s most of their rental sites were located at local service stations. Since C-stores have replaced most service stations many of their sites today are located at mini-self storage units.

### USF Holland (Truck Lines)



1996 (RMcN) US/Canada/Mexico (medium) road atlas back cover shows terminals with **black dots**.

### Wilson Freight

1979 Road Atlas-Back covers shows Terminals and routes: Portland (ME) to Atlanta to Oklahoma City to Milwaukee.

### Yellow Freight System



1973 RMcN US/Can medium road atlas has all terminals listed inside the back cover.

**Yellow** = All locations shown on map    **Bold** = Symbols used on maps printed in bold  
*Italics* = *Brief history of chain*

Not on the above list for reasons listed:

Most Bank road maps cover just one city or county. I have only listed the Bank road maps that cover an entire state.

Due to the sheer numbers I haven't listed Rent-a-Car, Chamber of Commerce and real-estate broker maps. Most of these just cover a single city or small area.

AAA maps and Trip-Tiks have exits marked G F L for Gas Food Lodging, but never listed any brands.

Most inter-city Railroads and all Airlines put out route maps with their timetables given to their customers. . I have not included any RR or airline maps on this list because they only show cities served and not any useful locations. .
