

There will be a Spring MapCon again, this year, at the AACA Museum in Hershey, PA. It will be a one-day event at the museum, Saturday April 9, from 9am - early afternoon. There won't be a hotel, guest speaker, or dinner... but there will be lots of maps from some vendors as well as our famous bargain table. So you will get to meet other collectors and buy, sell and trade maps: oil companies; officials; US; international; and PA Turnpike items.

If you are interested in vending, since there is no room-to-room, we have worked out a great deal with the museum. The museum will provide tables and coverings and admission for 2 for just \$35. An additional table would be just \$10. Since we want to encourage collectors to bring maps, it is also possible to pay \$18 for a half table and 1 admission!

You may have heard that our national MapCon event that has been at Hershey the last few years is moving to Kansas City. While the location will bring in lots of collectors from the region, it may be more difficult for collectors from the East to make it. If you are only able to do one event, it should be Kansas City, but otherwise come to Hershey!

Our road map exhibit this spring at the museum is "Why Did Gas Stations Love Road Maps" a travel through years of gas stations appearing on maps and how maps were used to promote business.
